Election Day Update for the Sept. 21 City of Ocala General and Special Election

Marion County, FL. September 21 - Marion County Supervisor of Elections Wesley Wilcox announces that voter turnout for the Sept. 21 City of Ocala General and Special Election exceeded the record turnout of any Ocala election since 2009. As of 10 AM, voter turnout reached 14.75%, and continues to increase. In 2019, the City of Ocala turnout was 14.45%. Unofficial voter turnout can be tracked on the homepage of www.VoteMarion.Gov, and is updated every 10 minutes.

Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. at all 19<u>Ocala polling locations</u>. Only voters who reside within the city limits of Ocala are eligible to vote. Voters must vote in the precinct in which they reside, and can lookup their voting location at www.VoteMarion.Gov. A current and valid photo and signature ID is required to vote.

Vote-by-mail ballots are due to the Election Center by 7 PM today, Sept. 21. A secure mail ballot drop box is available inside the Election Center, 981 NE 16th Street, and will be available until 7 PM. Vote-by-mail ballots cannot be accepted at any Election Day voting location.

A copy of the first set of unofficial election results will be posted by 7:30 p.m. at www.VoteMarion.Gov/ElectionResults and updated every 15 minutes until all precincts are completely reported. Vote-by-mail totals will be reported first, followed by election day precinct results. Results are unofficial until the final Canvassing Board meets and certifies the election.
